SUMO SUIT USER DISCLAIMER – FOR CUSTOMER USE

- 1. No person under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medication should use the Sumo Suits.
- 2. No persons who have suffered from any back, neck or head injuries or have any medical history which could reoccur or be affected from the use of this equipment should use this equipment.
- 3. The supervisor's safety instructions must be adhered to at all times.
- 4. Play does not commence until the supervising adult has agreed. If the supervisor says to stop play then it must be stopped immediately.
- 5. Make sure that the helmet, neck brace, suit and gloves are always worn and worn correctly during play as advised by the supervisor. Play must stop immediately should either opponent lose a piece of equipment.
- 6. Childrens suits, Spider-Man & The Hulk, are for ages 8-14 years and Superman & Batman are for ages 15+ only.
- 7. Any refusal of players to wear the required safety equipment will result in refused use of the equipment.
- 8. No eating, drinking, smoking, alcohol, shoes, glass, jewellery, buckles, spectacles, key rings, metal studded clothing, silly string, toys or sharp instruments or similar items which could cause injury or damage allowed on the Sumo equipment or within the safe area around the equipment. If removing spectacles affects your vision, you should not use this equipment.
- 9. Sumo suits are for the fun and enjoyment of both the players and observers, overly aggressive behaviour or repeatedly hitting your opponent excessively or body slamming them is NOT allowed and not in the spirit of the game, this will not improve your experience using the Sumo Suits but may hurt your opponent seriously.
- 10. The game rules for winning are to pin you opponent onto the floor or push them out of the circle.
- 11. If a player no longer wishes to play they should let the supervisor know and game play will be stopped.
